- Plants are 1.5' to 6' tall in easy to plant cylindrical containers, nurseries located in MTV and New Harmony, IN.

- **Planting and Care Guide Provided.** Planting is easy, caring requires a commitment: **mulch**, water when dry, protect from deer/mowers/trimmers.
